



There is a lot of confusion regarding the subject of the Holy Spirit in religious world today.

There is not enough preaching and teaching on the subject of the Holy Spirit.

Ignorance abounds.

Many have concluded that the subject is so difficult. So shrouded in mystery that it cannot be understood.

Superstition and opinion which contradict the Bible are nevertheless popular.

Much of what is taught in the church is reactionary.

An effort to offset the excesses of dry denominationalism or radical Pentecostalism.

It is hoped that this study can avoid reactionism and extremism, and simply search for the Biblical truth about the Holy Spirit, His work, and His relationship to us.

Who Is The Holy Spirit? Introduction. It is a fact Generally recognised and accepted by the theologians that in every generation the THEME OF THE HOLY SPIRIT, has been the least understood of all Christian doctrines.

This becomes very obvious when we listen to the theories that many so- called scholars have advanced. The fact is that their ideas have only made the water even more muddy!

1. The Spirit is A SEMI MATERIAL SUBSTANCE.

(Many German Theologians!)

- 2. AN ABSTRACT PRINCIPLE. (Whatever that may mean?)
- 3. AN INSTINCT or INFLUENCE or INSPIRATION WHICH DIRECTED THE N. T. CHURCH.
- 4. The COLLECTIVE SPIRIT which ANIMATES the COMMUNAL LIFE OF A BELIEVER.

When so-called scholars put out ideas such as these, is it surprising that ordinary believers do not feel very comfortable talking about the Holy Spirit?

In fact, WE CANNOT HELP WONDERING IF THESE MEN READ THE SAME BIBLE AS OURSELVES!

OR, IF THEY EVER READ THE BIBLE AT ALL!

There are, however, several other reasons for the confusion in the religious world, about the Holy Spirit.

- 1. The THIRD PERSON OF THE TRINITY is the description in the Oxford Dictionary.
- 2. He has NO PERSONAL, IDENTIFYING NAME.
- 3. He is called the Holy Ghost by The KJV Bible.

# Who Is The Holy Spirit? Introduction. WHY SHOULD WE STUDY THIS SUBJECT? Because many Christians DO NOT KNOW A GREAT DEAL ABOUT THE HOLY SPIRIT others know virtually nothing at all.

WHY is this the case?
Why so much ignorance and confusion?
Because for centuries it was a neglected subject.

#### **AUGUSTINE** who died in 430 A.D.

Wrote that there had not been "a discussion of the subject, full enough and careful enough to make it possible to obtain an intelligent understanding of the Holy Spirit's proper individuality."

## Who Is The Holy Spirit? Introduction. 1450 years later, in 1880 the GERMAN THEOLOGIAN ALBRECHT RITSCHL asked the question. "What is meant by the Holy Spirit?"

He then went on to say "that the subject has been so neglected by theologians that he, could not undertake the work that would be needed to answer the question.

Neglect of the subject has had the unfortunate consequence that some theologians, "ABSTAIN FROM USING THE IDEA ALTOGETHER."

of Tarsus' claimed that "NO ORIGINAL WORK (he meant no real study,) HAS BEEN DONE ON 'THE HOLY SPIRIT' SINCE THE DAYS OF THE APOSTLES'."

In 3rd century, PAUL OF SAMOSATA (d.272) a bishop in Antioch, denied the deity of Christ. AND taught that the Holy Spirit is an influence, or power exercised by God".

The result was that his views became the foundation of what was later called "UNITARIANISM".

The same view was revived about the time of the Reformation, by two POLISH theologians LAELIUS SOCINUS and his nephew FAUSTUS, and they developed a following, and the extent of their influence can still be seen in the "A.V" today!

The fact is that, when the A.V. came to be published.

They translated the personal pronoun used to describe the Holy Spirit as "IT."

As a mysterious spiritual influence or force.

Religious people spoke and prayed about the Holy Spirit as "IT":As a mysterious spiritual influence or force.
So that the religious world found it virtually impossible to relate to the Holy Spirit as a person or being.

Happily MODERN translations have corrected this error in the +264 times the Holy Spirit is mentioned in the N.T.

Among certain religious bodies:A great deal of confusion and error:- MORMONISM
President Joseph F. Smith, taught that the Holy Ghost and the
Holy Spirit are NOT the same. (DC.C. p.240)

James.E. Talmage, one of the "12 Apostles" of Mormonism, said that "they ARE the same." (Articles of Faith. p.159)

Brigham Young described the Holy Spirit as:"Ethereal substance, diffused through the universe."

## Who Is The Holy Spirit? Introduction. Jehovah's Witnesses "THE WATCHTOWER ORGANISATION" "The word "ghost" is from the Greek word which is properly translated "spirit" It does not mean a person or a creature or being, but means the power of Jehovah God, which power is invisible to the human eyes.

The holy spirit, otherwise translated "holy ghost", therefore means the invisible power of Jehovah, which is entirely devoted to righteousness or holiness."

Riches. p 188. (Notice no capital letters. GM)

## Who Is The Holy Spirit? Introduction. CHRISTADELPHIANS.

"Spirit concentrated under the Almighty's will, becomes Holy Spirit, as distinct from spirit in its free, spontaneous form."
(see pp. 95-96 "Christendom led Astray." by Robert Roberts.
(The Holy Spirit is really Holy Electricity! FW)

Even today it is occasionally said.
THE MORE YOU HAVE OF THE WORD OF GOD,
THE MORE YOU HAVE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT:Thus confusing the Spirit with the SCRIPTURES.

## Who Is The Holy Spirit? Introduction. CHRISTIAN SCIENCE.

"In the words of St John; "He shall give you another Comforter, that He may abide with you for ever" "Divine Science." (Science and Health)

"His students received the Holy Ghost."

"By this is meant, that by all they had witnessed and suffered they were aroused to an enlarged understanding of divine Science."

These quotations indicate
the degree of error and confusion
which has surrounded, - and still surroundsthe doctrine of the Holy Spirit.

### Who Is The Holy Spirit

The degree of NEGLECT, the doctrine of the Holy Spirit has suffered in the past is seen by the fact that:-

At the end of the last century, in the LIBRARY of one of our universities, THERE WERE some 2000 books on the life of Paul, and a mere handful about the Holy Spirit.

Sir William Ramsay wrote:"Paul the Traveller and Roman Citizen."
Which has at least 400 pages. He has just
3 pages dealing with Paul and the Holy Spirit.

About the miraculous gifts they claimed to possess, that ordinary Christians were often made to feel inferior.

## Who Is The Holy Spirit The so-called "Charismatic Movement".

Even invaded certain sections of the churches that are usually regarded as VERY ORTHODOX. Attracting emotional men and women who found the older churches too quiet and sober by comparison with the New Pentecostal bodies.

THE CHURCH OF ENGLAND, CHURCH OF SCOTLAND, BAPTIST, METHODIST CHURCHES, ETC. WERE AFFECTED BY THIS MOVEMENT. The "ALPHA Course" is a classic example.

What we need today is to go back to the word of God, to discover what it has to tell us about the Holy Spirit.

They all perform acts of worship and work, as well as advocating organizations which are foreign to the Word of God. Yet they all claim to be guided by the same Spirit:-**HOW CAN THAT BE?** 

The enemies of Jesus and the Apostles may not have liked their teachings or the threat they posed to their positions of authority over the people, but they never questioned that the miracles were real.

Jesus and the Apostles never failed to heal a person who came to them for healing.

They never used the persons lack of faith as an excuse for failure.

## The only time we see a failure to heal is in Matt 17:18-20;

"And Jesus rebuked him, and the demon came out of him, the boy was cured at once.

Then the disciples came to Jesus privately and said, "Why could we not drive it out?" And He said to them, "Because of the littleness of YOUR faith!"

The main point here is that after a long time with casting out demons and doing other miracles, the disciples started to trust in their own power.

In Matt 17:19; we see the real problem.

The ones who have the gift, (the disciples) were the ones who lacked faith.

Jesus blamed the DISCIPLES lack of faith NOT the sick persons lack of faith!.

They lost sight of the fact that they really could do nothing without faith in God's power. It is never the gifts that God gives us, it is always the giver, the Lord Jesus Christ, that matters.



60 or more references in the gospels.

Acts has 57 references.

(which is why some call it "The Acts Of The Holy Spirit.")

The letters refer to the Holy Spirit 132 times
Only 3 letters make no mention of the Spirit.
(Philemon, 2 & 3 John.)

#### HIS PRESENCE AT THE BAPTISM BY JOHN.

Descended in bodily form like a dove - Lk 3:21-22; "21. One day when the crowds were being baptized, Jesus himself was baptized.

As he was praying, the heavens opened, 22. and the Holy Spirit descended on Him in the form of a dove. And a voice from heaven said, "You are my beloved Son, I am pleased with you"



Even "alighting upon Him" - Mt 3:16; 16. "After his baptism, as Jesus came up out of the water, the heavens were opened And John saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and settling on Him."

#### HIS PRESENCE DURING THE TEMPTATIONS.

Jesus was "filled with the Holy Spirit" - Lk 4:1;

"Then Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit,
left the Jordan River. He was led by the Spirit
to go out into the wilderness."

Matt 4:1-2; "Then Jesus was led out into the wilderness by the Holy Spirit to be tempted there by the Devil. For forty days and forty nights He ate nothing and became very hungry."



#### Holy Spirit's power during Jesus' ministry...

Jesus returned from His temptations "in the power of the Spirit" to teach in the synagogues. Lk 4:14-15;

"Then Jesus returned to Galilee, filled with the Holy Spirit's power. Soon He became well known throughout the surrounding country. He taught in their synagogues and was praised by everyone."

#### Holy Spirit's power during Jesus' ministry...

He applied Isaiah's prophecy to Himself, which said "The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me..." Lk 4:16-21; 17. "The scroll containing the messages of Isaiah the prophet was handed to Him, and He unrolled the scroll to the place where it says:-

18."The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, for he has appointed me to preach Good News to the poor.
19. He has sent me to proclaim that captives will be released, that the blind will see, that the downtrodden will be freed from their oppressors."

# Holy Spirit's power during Jesus' ministry... On one occasion it is said that Jesus. "rejoiced in the Spirit."

Lk 10:21; "Then Jesus was filled with the joy of the Holy Spirit and said, "O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, thank you for hiding the truth from those who think themselves so wise and clever, and for revealing it to the childlike. Yes, Father, it pleased you to do it this way."

Jesus claimed to cast out demons by the power of the Holy Spirit. - Mt 12:28; "But if I am casting out demons by the Spirit of God, then the Kingdom of God has arrived among you." His prominence in "the Christian's life"

THE SPIRITS INVOLVEMENT
IN OUR BECOMING CHRISTIANS...
We are convicted of sin by the Holy Spirit. Jn 16:7-8;
"But it is actually best for you that I go away,
because if I don't, the Counsellor won't come.
If I do go away, he will come because
I will send him to you.

8. And when he comes, he will convince the world of its sin, and of God's righteousness, and of the coming judgment.

#### HIS INVOLVEMENT IN OUR BECOMING CHRISTIANS.

We are "born again" of the Spirit - Jn 3:5-8;

"Jesus replied, "The truth is, no one can enter the Kingdom of God without being born of water and the Spirit.

6. Humans can reproduce only human life, but the Holy Spirit gives new life from heaven."

"7. So don't be surprised at my statement that you must be born again. 8. Just as you can hear the wind but can't tell where it comes from or where it is going, so you can't explain how people are born of the Spirit."

HIS INVOLVEMENT IN OUR BECOMING CHRISTIANS.
We are "renewed" of the Holy Spirit - Tit 3:4-6;
"But then God our Saviour showed us his kindness and love. 5. He saved us, not because of the good things we did, but because of his mercy.
He washed away our sins and gave us a new life through the Holy Spirit."

We "live in the Spirit." - Gal 5:25a; "25. If we are living now by the Holy Spirit, let us follow the Holy Spirit's leading in every part of our lives. 26. Let us not become conceited, or irritate one another, or be jealous of one another.



# THE HOLY SPIRIT DWELLS IN THE CHRISTIAN.

Romans 8:9;

"But you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he is not His."

We are to "walk in the Spirit", Gal 5:16-18;

"But I say, walk by the Spirit, and do not gratify the desires of the flesh. 17. The old sinful nature loves to do evil, which is just opposite from what the Holy Spirit wants. And the Spirit gives us desires that are opposite from what the sinful nature desires.


These two forces are constantly fighting each other, and your choices are never free from this conflict.

18. But when you are directed by the Holy Spirit, you are no longer subject to the law."

We are to "walk in the Spirit.", producing the "fruit of the Spirit" - Gal 5:22-23; "The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such there is no law."







It is "by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body" Rom 8:11-13; "The Spirit of God, who raised Jesus from the dead, lives in you. And just as he raised Christ from the dead, he will give life to your mortal body by this same Spirit living within you"

"So, dear brothers and sisters, you have no obligation whatsoever to do what your sinful nature urges you to do. 13. For if you keep on following it, you will perish. But if through the power of the Holy Spirit you turn from it and its evil deeds, you will live."

Only when "led by the Spirit" are we truly the "sons of God" Rom 8:14; "For all who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God."



The Holy Spirit "makes intercession for us" in our prayers:- Rom 8:26-27; "And the Father who knows all hearts knows what the Spirit is saying, for the Spirit pleads for us believers in harmony with God's own will."

"And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to His purpose for them."

God strengthens us "with might through His Spirit" in the inner man. - Eph 3:16-17;

"I pray that from His glorious, unlimited resources
He will give you mighty inner strength
through His Holy Spirit.

And I pray that Christ will be more and more
at home in your hearts as you trust in Him.
May your roots go down deep into
the soil of God's marvellous love."

Thus we can enjoy the "communion (fellowship)
of the Spirit" - 2Cor 13:14;
"May the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ,
the love of God, and the
fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all."

Phil 2:1-2; "Is there any encouragement from belonging to Christ? Any comfort from His love? Any fellowship together in the Spirit? Are your hearts tender and sympathetic?

2. Then make me truly happy by agreeing wholeheartedly with each other, loving one another, and working together with one heart and purpose."

## Who Is The Holy Spirit

The Providence of God. This will involve us in the whole question of whether the Holy Spirit does anything now apart from the written word of God, or in addition to it.

The Holy Spirit's work in conversion and redemption. John 16:8-13, Heb 9:14;
The Holy Spirit's work in vitalizing the church and the Christian. John 3:5, Rom 8:10;

The Holy Spirit is to be properly honoured and worshipped as God the Spirit.

We are now living in a time which might properly be called "the age of the Holy Spirit," since He is the prominent member of the Godhead present within us on earth.

His prominence in "the Christian's life"

Future lessons will discuss
all these things in greater detail.

Suffice it to say that since the Holy Spirit is so involved in our lives as Christians.

It encourages us to understand the proper relationship we are to maintain with the Spirit!



Prominence of the Spirit regarding "truth and error."
2 Pet 1:18-21; "We ourselves heard the voice
when we were there with Him on the holy mountain.
Because of that, we have even greater confidence
in the message proclaimed by the prophets.

Pay close attention to what they wrote, for their words are like a light shining in a dark place, until the day Christ appears and His brilliant light shines in your hearts.

20. Above all, you must understand that no prophecy in Scripture ever came from the prophets themselves, or because they wanted to prophesy. It was the Holy Spirit who moved the prophets to speak from God."

- Prominence of the Spirit regarding "truth and error."
  HE IS THE SOURCE OF GOD'S TRUTH...
  - 1. The O.T. scriptures with their prophecies came through the agency of the Holy Spirit. 1 Pet 1:10-11; 2Pet 1:20-21;

1Pet 1:10-11; "This salvation was something the prophets wanted to know more about. They prophesied about this gracious salvation prepared for you, even though they had many questions as to what it all could mean.

11. They wondered what the Spirit of Christ within them was talking about when He told them in advance about Christ's suffering and His great glory afterward. They wondered when and to whom all this would happen."

# Prominence of the Spirit regarding "truth and error." HE IS THE SOURCE OF GOD'S TRUTH...

- 2. Jesus told His apostles that the Holy Spirit would teach them "all things", and guide them "into all truth." John 14:24-26; 16:12-13;
- Jn 14:24-26; "Anyone who doesn't love me will not do what I say. And remember, my words are not my own. This message is from the Father who sent me. I am telling you these things now while I am still with you.
- 26. But when the Father sends the Counsellor as My representative, and by the Counsellor, I mean the Holy Spirit, He will teach you everything and will remind you of everything I myself have told you." W.E.B.

# Prominence of the Spirit regarding "truth and error" HE IS THE SOURCE OF GOD'S TRUTH...

2. Jesus told His apostles that the Holy Spirit would teach them "all things", and guide them "into all truth."

John 14:24-26;16:12-13;

Jn 16:12-13; "Oh, there is so much more I want to tell you, but you can't bear it now. When the Spirit of truth comes, He will guide you into all truth.

He will not be presenting His own ideas; He will be telling you what He has heard. He will tell you about the future.

14. He will bring Me glory by revealing to you whatever He receives from Me."

# Prominence of the Spirit regarding "truth and error." HE IS THE SOURCE OF GOD'S TRUTH. 1Cor 2:10-13; There is no other way to know the truth of God's Will except by what the Holy Spirit revealed to the apostles.

11."No one can know what anyone else is really thinking except that person alone, and no one can know God's thoughts except God's own Spirit.

- 12. And God has actually given us His Spirit (not the world's spirit) so we can know the wonderful things God has freely given us.
- 13. When we tell you this, we do not use words of human wisdom. We speak words given to us by the Spirit, using the Spirit's words to explain spiritual truths."

#### THE HOLY SPIRIT IS THE SUBJECT OF MUCH ERROR.

- Error is taught about the nature of the Holy Spirit.

  a. Some think He is an impersonal force
  expressive of God's power.
  - b. Others think He is really Jesus in another form.

Many people misunderstand:a. The baptism of the Holy Spirit.
b. The gift of the Holy Spirit.

c. The spiritual gifts of the Holy Spirit. d. The indwelling of the Holy Spirit.

#### THE HOLY SPIRIT IS THE SUBJECT OF MUCH ERROR...

- Many attribute "impressions or "intuitive feelings" to being "led by the Spirit."
- a. They are Ignorant of how the Holy Spirit leads us.
  b. They are often Attributing to the "Holy Spirit"
  what is really the "human spirit."

It should be evident that our subject is indeed an important one.

As our understanding of the Holy Spirit increases, so will our appreciation for Him.

THE HOLY SPIRIT OF GOD IS A PERSON.
Definition: a person is an identifiable being,
capable of action, able to sustain relationships, etc.
The word "person" says nothing
about form, limitations, location, etc.

It is easy to see Jesus of Nazareth as a person, the Son of God.

We can identify Him historically, geographically, and physically - in human form.

Matthew 16:16; He was Son of God on earth, and is Son of God in heaven.

We forget that He Was God and Will be God again. When He became flesh He became identified as the Son and when He finishes His redemptive work He will be identified again as God. John 17:5;

#### THE HOLY SPIRIT OF GOD IS A PERSON.

It is more difficult to view God as a person. We often speak of Him in human terms. We speak as though He had a body and parts as man has, even though we know that God is spirit (John 4:24).

We are accustomed to thinking of God as:Someone to whom we can
direct our prayers, praises, etc.
He is often identified as the Father,
God the Heavenly Father.

### THE HOLY SPIRIT OF GOD IS A PERSON.

But the problem of thinking of the Holy Spirit as a person is difficult because we cannot assign Him a form, or location.

The Holy Spirit is not a "FORCE," an attribute of God, or an INFLUENCE.

Some reduce Him to A MERE FIGURE OF SPEECH, OR TO A WRITTEN WORD, the Bible.

Others think of Him as the breath, ENERGY, or manifest power and influence of God.

But He is MUCH MORE He is not just "a manifestation of God's power."

THE HOLY SPIRIT OF GOD IS A PERSON.

The term Holy Ghost (in the KJV)
should probably be avoided.

"Ghost" is a bit spookysounding, and frightening to some.

"Ghost" is from the Saxon "geist"
It can mean "guest."
He is the Holy Guest. That expression
is rich with possible implications
about the indwelling of the Holy Spirit.

# THE HOLY SPIRIT OF GOD IS A PERSON THE HUMAN SPIRIT:-

"The body without spirit is dead." James 2:26; "May your whole spirit and soul and body be kept blameless." 1Thess 5:23;

THE HOLY SPIRIT OF GOD IS A PERSON The Hebrew RUACH and the Greek PNEUMA which are translated as "spirit" can also mean wind, breath, life, vitality, etc. and are so used in the scriptures.

O.T. Heb-RUACH.
Used approximately 200 times.
Literally "wind", "breath".
